- 3. That all costs associated with this conditional use incurred by the Municipality shall be the sole responsibility of the property owner.
- 4. That the applicant/owner is limited to what is noted in the application and any intensification of operations will require a new conditional use application.
- **5.** That proof of liability insurance be provided to the Municipality.

- 4. That no more than 5 dogs shall have residence on the property at any time.
- 5. That the designate Animal Control Officers for the Rural Municipality of Brokenhead has the authority to at any time attend the property to inspect the facilities, check compliance with the number of dogs and for any concerns of the neighbouring citizens.
